RESTORATION OF THE LORD'S TEMPLE; THE HUMAN BODY



Man is created in the image of God according to the Bible in Genesis 1:26.

We like to say I look like God. But that's not what image means in that context. If it was based on that, Jesus should have been identified on sight. The image referred to can best be compared to a computer operating system (OS) image that is used to reproduce the same capabilities across a fleet of devices.

As humans, we carry the possibilities of God which have been installed in us. Why do you think He says "ye are gods" in Psalm 82:6? Jesus is a blueprint of one who deployed that installed image maximally and you can tell from the results of His life and ministry.

So, how much of that nature is your life experiencing and manifesting?

But as powerful as an image is, the ability to bring the image to life to the fullest expression of its abilities is dependent on the quality and the capacity of the body carrying it (Psalm 82:6-7).

Who said your body is not important to God? Read Romans 12:1-3. Our body is the final part of the complete circuit that God needs to transmit His possibilities in this world. Hence, it's very important, or God would not have sort out a virgin to birth his son. It's not that he hates others, it's just that the body matters.

This is exactly why your body is a point of interest to the enemy. Satan may not be able to stop you from answering the altar call (which addresses your spirit) but he will not stop hitting at your body/vessel to limit the expression of the possibilities of your response to the altar call.

You'll notice that anything that looks like a body, individual, or corporate (the church) is within the range of what he looks to attack given the chance. Mostly, he either does it by attacking it with sickness/disease or causing you to defile it (1 Corinthians 3:17).

This is why the healing ministry is important. For example, the slew of attacks that the enemy lobbs at a woman's body simply on account of being able to host life and bring it to this realm is proof to you that Satan is not joking about the body. The pressure he puts on the men to ensure that they get to where they willingly defile their bodies through sexual immorality and other habits so that it's inadequate for the purposes of God.

While the attack with sickness and disease is a violation, if the enemy can get you to defile your own body, you bring yourself to a place where you can become a legal captive.

Though the enemy has this whole evil agenda planned out, understand that he's not powerful enough to carry it out without consent from you. Either by your ignorance or your violation of God's laws. The believer has a card that will win over the enemy's attacks any day which is prayer.

This is why Jesus says "My house shall be called a house a prayer but you have made it a den of thieves" (Matthew 21:13). This is not just talking about a building. You are the temple of God so this refers to you. Your body can be a house of feasting and fanfare or a house of prayers.

You must learn to subject this body to prayer. Put it under the weight of prayer so it learns to stay down and not respond to every antic of the enemy who launches a lot of pressure against people to make them defile their bodies.

Why not retrieve your body, and put it under the pressure of prayer instead? It's pressure either ways. Only that one serves you and the other destroys you.
